

MINUTES OF JANUARY 10, 2018 MEETING

A meeting of the Longmeadow Conservation Commission was called to order at 7:00 P.M. on January 10, 2018 in the conference room at the Longmeadow Police Station.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Chair, Al Laakso, Peter Bouvier, David Dumais, Andrea Chasen, Stephen Gazillo; Absent: John Bresnahan, Wayne Ottani.

OTHERS PRESENT: Mike Richard, Mario Mazza

MINUTES OF PRIOR MEETING: The minutes of December 13, 2017 were accepted.

TREASURER'S REPORT: Salary Account \$4150, Maintenance \$300, Office Supplies \$100, Misc. \$800, Con Com Trust Fund \$9016.26, Con Com Wetland Protection Fund \$7524.65.

NOI 205-326 DPW PROJECT, 170 DWIGHT RD – The hearing continued. As there were no objections to the plan from the Commissioners and it was determined there was no intrusion to the buffer zone, Chair Al Laakso closed the hearing. A motion was made to approve the NOI based on Plan Title Town of Longmeadow, 170 Dwight Rd with the final date of December 4, 2017 and to issue an OOC to allow construction of the DPW facility as previously noted with the following conditions: Per Section 4.4 of Attachment H in the Stormwater Report, fallen trees and limbs may be removed from the stream channel and ravine slopes north and west of the site as an ongoing condition. The removal of any rooted trees will require a permit from the Conservation Commission. The motion passed unanimously 5-0.

OTHER BUSINESS: Commissioner Andrea Chasen spoke about her working with FEMA for several weeks in Houston, Texas re: the National Hurricane Disaster that occurred. On March 3, 2018 the MACC will hold its annual conference at Holy Cross College. The CC was notified that a tree had fallen on CC land at Briarcliff Road and that the DPW had taken care of the removal of it. Bark Haul Road area was flooded again due to Beaver activity. The Tennessee Gas Pipeline contacted Chair Al Laakso that it would be coming before the CC at a later date with a RDA. Commissioner Peter Bouvier reported that the cost of 2 signs, citing CC Rules and Regulations to be posted on CC land, would be about \$120 each.

Meeting adjourned at 7:45 PM.
