- 2. **Review of 2017 Applications:** Two projects remained to be discussed and voted upon.
 - 2017-6 Wolf Swamp Road Field Irrigation
 - Open Space and Recreation
 - This project was approved for partial funding: \$80,000
 - The motion was to approve \$80,000 for improvements to the Wolf Swamp Road fields, specifically to install the well and pump., contingent upon the development of a master plan for the fields.
 - Vote: Approve = 9; Reject = 0
 - Amount requested = \$210,000
 - Amount Approved: \$80,000

2017-13 Storrs Library Window Replacement

- This project was approved.
- A motion was made to approve the Storrs Library Window replacement project at \$118,000, contingent upon the reallocation of \$132,500 of CPC finds from the Center School Ballistrad project being applied to the window project.
- Vote: Approve = 9; Reject = 0;

- Amount approved = \$\$118,000
