Site and Design for Wireless Edge Towers – Case# 20180404-1:

The planning board is voting for a public hearing continuance for Wireless Edge. Donald Holland made a motion for a continuance at the request of the applicant to the next scheduled meeting. Ken Taylor seconded the motion. All members voting in favor, no opposes 5/0.

The board discussed the reasoning for the delay, as it was not stated by the applicant. Bruce Colton made a suggestion to send Wireless Edge a letter to withdraw the application and resubmit when they are ready to proceed. It was mentioned that maybe Verizon Wireless was holding up the process. Don Holland made a suggestion that notification should be sent to Wireless Edge advising that the Planning Board will not accept another continuance based on the Planning Boards timelines, deadlines and agreements. Walter Gunn will draft a letter to Ed Pare, the attorney for Wireless Edge advising him that no more continuances will be accepted by the board after the August hearing.
